Important dates:

Wednesday, August 16th from 7:45 AM - 3:00 PM - 7th Grade BOOT (Basic Optimal Organizational Training) Camp

Important updates:

- Fees are accessible for all junior high families through the Infinite Campus [Parent Portal](#) and should be paid prior to the first day of school.
- The Secondary Parent/Student Handbook is accessible through the [Infinite Campus Parent Portal](#). Please read and digitally sign before the first week of school.

Handbook adjustments to note this year:

- You will notice that all levels of TCA have updated their digital device guidelines. These guidelines are consistent with past year's enforcement the junior high. The only additional guideline is that students are encouraged to leave all digital devices (including cell phones) off and in their lockers during the entire school day. Students bringing them to class will need to place them in a digital device box during class time. Students desiring to call home during the school day will need to do so while in the office.

- Pickup information has been adjusted to work around construction and support the adjustments to the elementary pickup time. All junior high students that are not attending a junior high afterschool workshop must be picked up within 20 minutes of the end of the school day. Specific guidelines for students that pick up their elementary siblings will be sent in a separate email after the first day of school.
- Carpool Information / Guidelines to help you navigate around the construction will be sent in a separate email closer to the start of school.

Summer Reading: Students will have summer reading each year during their time at the secondary school. All seventh grade students read "Roll of Thunder, Hear My Cry" by Mildred Taylor and one other book from the seventh grade list. Dress Code for Junior High: The dress code at the secondary school is similar to the elementary with a few more options with respect to color and outerwear choices.
