Winter Sports Registration:

All registration requirements must be completed by 11/07/22 (one week prior to the first practice date of 11/14/22). Registration after this date must have special circumstances and approved by the Athletic Director. DO NOT BE LATE. Registration will open for High School Winter Sports (Men's and Women's Basketball, Wrestling) on 09/29/22.

- A current physical is required before the start of the Winter season and must be good through the sports season you are registering for.
- All forms can be found on the TCA Activities website.
- College Pathway students and other non traditional TCA students must be assigned to TCA each year we have to have a new assignment letter signed by D20 <u>no exceptions</u>. If you have participated in sports at TCA in previous years, this won't be an issue, but we must have a form for the 2022-23 school year. You must also complete an Eligibility Form indicating grade for the previous semester and that you are taking enough credits in the current semester to participate in Athletics. Both of these forms will need to be uploaded by the Family to their sports registration.
- The activity fee is required to be paid, or have a payment plan set up, the day before the first competition (including scrimmage). It can be paid on-line through Infinite Campus, by calling Finance at 488-6237 or a check dropped off to the Finance Office. Please communicate with the Athletic Director if there are monetary issues.



Cross Country

The cross country team will begin the 2022 campaign this Saturday, Aug 27, at the "Vista Nation 2-Mile Invitational" on the Mountain Vista High School campus. We currently have 42 athletes on the roster, which is the largest team TCA has seen in several years, and many of them worked hard all summer in preparation for the season. Both boys and girls are the defending 3A champions and are pursuing another. Coaches and athletes are talking about building the foundation of the team on joy and taking care of one another, and our 21 juniors and seniors are providing great leadership and example of those ideals. The state meet is again at Norris Penrose Equestrian Center/Bear Creek Park (here in Colorado Springs) on Saturday, October 29, and we'd love to have as many Titan fans there as possible.

The boys' golf team competed in their first, non-league tournament on Aug 10, at Saddle Rock golf course in Aurora. At Canon City this past Thursday the team came in 3rd place out of 27 teams. They were led by Nathan Valentine, a junior at CP, with a 74. His brother, Zac, a freshman, had an 84. Senior and team captain, Ryan Heiser, had his best score with an 81. Junior Cage Fontana rounds out the top 4 and had an 89. We begin league play next week with two tournaments. 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
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
