Last Friday we met with our Titan Buddies for the first time to discuss social intelligence. Social intelligence is being aware of the feelings of other people and yourself. We talked about listening to others and played a game with our buddies to practice listening and getting to know someone. Follow up questions could be to ask what the difference is between sincerely listening and selffocused listening. Gincerely listening is when you have a deep need for ALL people to be understood and you put yourself in others' shoes. You can practice sincerely listening by repeating back what the other person says.
