CogAT Testing

Your third-grade child will be taking the Cognitive Ability Test (CogAT). The CogAT measures a student's potential problemsolving skills in the areas of verbal ability (word analogies and sentence completion), quantitative ability (numeric) and nonverbal reasoning ability (puzzles, partto-whole, and visual spatial manipulation of pictures). The test results provide us with important information helpful in meeting your student's unique learning needs. Your student will be taking the test September 25-27. The test will take place first thing in the morning, please be sure that your child is at school on time.
