Concert Attire:

Performing a concert is a special occasion. Our gift to the audience is to dress up for concert, share our voices, and be our best self. All concert wear should align with the dress up day guidelines in the TCA Elementary Handbook. The following are allowed items for concert dress; however, students may wear their uniform if they choose.

Dress pants and a dress shirt (nicer than uniform). Ties or suits are allowed. Sweater or vest may be worn over a dress shirt.

A dress or skirt/blouse (nicer than uniform). Dresses or skirts must be 3 inches above the knee or longer. Leggings may be worn under a dress for warmth, but not as pants.

The following items are <u>not</u> allowed in concert dress: any denim, any neon colors, t-shirts, spaghetti straps, flip-flops, make-up, hats, heels above 1 inch, or large jewelry.
