All concert wear should align with the dress up day guidelines in the TCA Elementary Handbook. The following are allowed items for concert dress; however, students may wear their uniform if they choose.

Dress pants and a dress shirt (nicer than uniform). Ties or suits are allowed. Sweater or vest may be worn over a dress shirt.

A dress or skirt/blouse (nicer than uniform). Dresses or skirts must be 3 inches above the knee or longer. Leggings may be worn under a dress for warmth, but not as pants.

The following items are <u>not</u> allowed in concert dress: any denim, any neon colors, t-shirts, spaghetti straps, flip-flops, make-up, hats, heels above 1 inch, or large jewelry.
