## Practice Multiplication Facts With "Going to Boston"

## Materials: 3 dice, paper \& pen for scoring

Have each player roll one die. The player with the highest number goes first. Each player in turn rolls all three of the dice. After the first throw, remove the die with the highest number and put it aside. Roll the two remaining dice and again put the highest number aside. Add the sum of the first two dice. Roll the last die. Take the sum of the first two dice and multiply it by the third number. Record the score on a pad of paper. Continue taking turns moving clockwise around the table until all players have had a turn. The highest score for the round wins. Play a number of rounds and either add up a combined score or tally winning rounds.
