Dissection: Owl Pellets

Our Owl Pellet Dissection in Science is coming up at the beginning of May.

Students and volunteers will be dissecting owl pellets to piece together the contents of an owl's diet. This dissection connects with our unit on the Human Senses and Movement. It will help students better understand our skeletal system.

Quick Stop: A Multiplication Game

Compete for the highest score as you flip over cards. Add up your cards until you reach 1000 points. The first one there wins!

What You Need: deck of cards, pencil and paper for every player

What You Do:

1. Place a well shuffled deck of cards, face down, in the center of the playing area.
2. Each player begins by drawing one card and placing it face up in front of themselves. Players write the value of this card down at the top of their papers. (Aces are worth 1, and face cards are all 10.)
3. When all players are ready, everyone draws a second card. They multiply the value of these cards and add to their totals.
4. Keep playing until one player reaches 1000.

Variations:

- Play until the deck runs out. The player closest to 1000, without going over, wins.
- Add jokers into the deck. If a player draws a joker, their score drops back to zero.
- Start with 1000 points, and subtract your way to the finish.
