We understand that it is the end of the year and that you are trying to get through these last few weeks without purchasing new uniform items. HOWEVER, we have noticed a great deal of uniform infractions, and are asking that you continue to adhere to the TCA uniform policy as we bring this year to a close. Please pay close attention to the following items, as they tend to be the most commonly neglected uniform details:

-Belts <u>must be worn</u> with pants or shorts

- -Polos <u>must be long enough to stay tucked in</u> (no long sleeves underneath)
 - -Sweaters and Polos may only be green, blue, white, or red
- **-Pants** $\underline{\text{may not}}$ have outside pockets and $\underline{\text{may not}}$ be legging/jegging material
 - -Pants, Shorts, Skirts may only be blue, khaki, (or plaid if skirt/dress)
 - -Leggings may only be worn under skirts and may not have holes
 - -Socks and Shoes must be of a $\underline{neutral}$ or $\underline{uniform}$ color
