Multiplication Fact Practice

This is the year to learn all the multiplication facts. Please begin working with your child on the x1's and x2's facts, which will be due on September 14th. You may use the multiplication fact cards you bought to review these facts at home. Once your child has these facts committed to memory, you can move on to x5's and x10's which are due September 29th. Then you can work numerically from x3's to x12's. It is worth your time to help your child have these facts learned for life!

CogAT Testing

Part of third grade includes students taking the Cognitive Ability Test (CogAT). CogAT measures a student's potential problem-solving skills in the areas of verbal ability (word analogies and sentence completion), quantitative ability (numeric) and nonverbal reasoning ability (puzzles, part-to-whole, and visual spatial manipulation of pictures). The test results provide us with important information helpful in meeting your student's unique learning needs. Your student will be taking the test September 25, 26, and 27. Please make sure your child is here on those days.
