TCA- East Elementary In Our Curriculum

<u>Spelling</u>- In class, we continue to enter our Spalding spelling rules. We will have our first spelling test September 15th.

<u>Math</u>– We will complete lessons 5-8 of chapter 1 this week. Our first math test is Friday Sept. 1. Please check math workbooks to ensure completion. We correct lessons and check for understanding in class.

Writing– This week we will model then scaffold how to complete a key word outline (KWO).

<u>Reading</u>– <u>Misty of Chincoteague</u> by Marguerite Henry is our first literature book. <u>The Hobbit</u> by J.R.R. Tolkien is our read aloud story.

<u>*History*</u>- In our Medieval unit, we will discuss the slow changes that occurred in Europe after 476 EC during the time known as the Dark Ages.

<u>Science</u>– We continue to learn about Energy Transfers and Transformation.

<u>Grammar</u>– We begin <u>Fix It! Gram-</u> <u>mar</u> this week. Students will practice cursive as they copy "The Nose Tree" in their notebooks.
