

# **Practicing Good Habits**

# **CogAT Testing**

Part of third grade includes students taking the Cognitive Ability Test (CogAT). CogAT measures a student's potential problem-solving skills in the areas of verbal ability (word analogies and sentence completion), quantitative ability (numeric) and nonverbal reasoning ability (puzzles, part-to-whole, and visual spatial manipulation of pictures). The test results provide us with important information helpful in meeting your student's unique learning needs. Your student will be taking the test September 25, September 26, and September 27. The test will be from 8:30-9:30 each day. Please make sure your child is here during those times.
