In Our Curriculum

Spelling— We will enter List 2 into our spelling books this week. Our test is on Friday and will include a written narration of rule 29.

<u>Math</u>— We have started chapter 3, which is Multiples and Factors. Here is a <u>Chapter 3 Summary</u> to help you understand how the concepts are being taught. It is very important for students to know their multiplication facts.

Writing This week we will scaffold a summary of an informative paper. It will include the KWO, rough draft, revisions & edits, and final draft.

Reading— We continue reading <u>Misty</u> of <u>Chincoteague</u> by Marguerite Henry this week. <u>The Hobbit</u> by J.R.R. Tolkien is our read aloud book.

History– This week in our Middle Ages unit, we will learn what it takes to become a knight and the required 'Code of Chivalry', which they live by.

Science We continue with our unit on "Investigating Waves" this week.

<u>Grammar</u>— We will identify pronouns in <u>Fix It! Grammar</u> this week. Students copy the sentences from the grammar workbook into their notebook.

Poetry Monthly Recitation— We have two short recitations this month: Dreams by Langston Hughes and Afternoon on a Hill by Edna St. Vincent Millay. Students have copies of both in their take home binder.
