Spelling Rule 11

Words ending in silent e are written without e when adding an ending that begins with a vowel.

Spelling— We will enter List 3 into our spelling books this week. Our test is on Friday and will include a written narration of rule 11.

Math— We continue in chapter 3, with the chapter test on Wednesday. Here is a <u>Chapter 3 Summary</u> to help you understand how the concepts are being taught. It is very important for students to know their multiplication facts.

Writing This week we will model the process of summarizing a narrative using a story sequence chart

Reading— We continue reading Misty of Chincoteague by Marguerite Henry for literature. The Hobbit by J.R.R. Tolkien is our read aloud book.

History– This week in our Middle Ages unit, we will learn about Henry II and Eleanor of Aquitaine.

Science— We continue with our unit on Investigating Waves.

<u>Grammar</u>— We will learn about which clauses in <u>Fix It! Grammar</u> this week. Students copy the sentences from the grammar workbook into their notebook.
