TCA- East Elementary In Our Curriculum

Spelling- We will enter list 10 into our spelling books with our test on Friday. It will include a written narration of rule 28.

<u>Math</u>- We are adding and subtracting fractions in Chapter 7. The chapter test will be Wednesday, Dec. 6. Please check math workbooks to ensure completion. We correct lessons and check for understanding in class.
