Math- Our test on chapter 12, Decimals, is Monday, 3/18. Our next chapter is on adding and subtracting decimals. The TCA East fourth grade webpage has a chapter summary with an overview of this concept.

Writing- This week, students will write paragraphs from writing prompts.

Reading- We continue reading Pollyanna by Eleanor H. Porter in literature class. Our read aloud book is Little Britches by Ralph Moody.

History- The students will learn about the writing of the Declaration of Independence and the disadvantages the Colonial troops faced.

Science- In science we are exploring natural resources.

Grammar- In our Fix It! Grammar, we will review adjectives and clause starters as we continue to copy the story in our notebooks.
