<u>Rule 13</u>

Sh is used at the beginning or end of a word or at the end of a syllable, but never at the beginning of a syllable after the first one. The exception is -ship as in friendship.



Spelling This week we will enter list 20 into our spelling books with our test on Friday. The test will also include a written narration of rule 13.

Math– We continue with chapter 12, Decimals. The TCA East fourth grade webpage has a chapter summary with an overview of this concept.

Writing- This week, students will begin our unit on poetry.

Reading— We continue reading <u>Pollyanna</u> by Eleanor H. Porter in literature class. Our read aloud book is <u>Little Britches</u> by Ralph Moody.

<u>History</u>- Students will read about the First Continental Congress and the Battles of Lexington and Concord while we highlight Paul Revere's famous ride.

<u>Science</u>- We are exploring Maps and World Mountains.

Grammar– In our Fix It! Grammar, we continue to identify and mark the parts of speech as we copy the story in our notebooks.

Poetry Monthly Recitation-

The March recitation is *George Washington* by Rosemary and Stephen Vincent Benet. Students will copy the poem at school to have a copy in their planner for memorization.
