\*Please buy specified brands on the supply list and please sharpen all pencils.

PLEASE LABEL ahead of time and bring these items to our First Day of School.

- \* Scissors (rounded tips)
- \* Prang watercolors
- \* Paint Shirt Name BOLDLY across front and back. Adult size old, **white** cotton **t- shirt**. (Please, NO dress shirts...T-shirt works best).
- \*Backpack Standard size please (not pre-school size and no rollers).
- \*Extra uniform clothing inside large Ziplock baggie for accidents.
- \* Label crayons & all color markers with sharpie, <u>no labels</u> on tools. Do not label expo markers or pencils. On the Orientation night the teacher will discuss supplies.

#### C. TAKE HOME FOLDER

Each day the **plastic** folder (with brads & pockets) will come home in your child's backpack. This is our way to communicate with you daily.

# F. CARPOOL FOR SAFETY REASONS:

You may drop your child off at the carpool lane or park and walk them up. If you are late, you MUST park and walk them up. You must then stop by the office for a late pass. NEVER send your kindergartener to class alone if they are late!!

- When dropping off, have your child exit the car on the passenger side of the car. Please inform others who are picking up your child of this procedure.
- Have your child in a car seat so they can exit quickly. You may need to teach them to get
  in and out of the car safely and quickly.
- If a child is going home with someone other than their parents, you **MUST add** them to Infinite Campus as an emergency contact.
- We will give you a car tag with your child's last name & teacher's name on the tag. You will put it on the passenger's side (windshield) when you are driving up for carpool. It helps us identify your car so we can quickly hand off your child.

# G. **VOLUNTEERING IN CLASSROOM & Field Trips-** please do this the first week of School!

- Grandparents will have additional forms to complete along with a background check. It may take longer to process.
- You may sign up tonight on the clipboard or on a later day that is convenient.
- Please do not bring siblings when volunteering in the classroom.
- You may also volunteer to do "busy bee" work at home. (Cutting, etc.).
- You will be required to sign a STATEMENT OF CONFIDENTIALITY form before you volunteer in the classroom **Please complete the form online**.
- For security reasons you will need to sign in at the office and get a VOLUNTEER BADGE before coming to the classroom. Parents are required to enter & exit through the front building where you sign in.
  - \*\*\*There are also opportunities for parents to share their knowledge/expertise/experiences, which would be beneficial educationally to the students. Please inform me if this would be of interest to you. \*

#### **Descriptions of Volunteers needed:**

Your classroom teacher may have additional needs.

Volunteer packets please complete ASAP even if you are not sure you will be able to come in.

- **Room Parents** Helps the teacher from time to time with specific needs. Some duties may include creating a phone tree or making calls for a special need or passing on important short notice information. Assists the teacher for class functions.
- <u>Library Assistant/ Art Assistant</u>- Someone to assist during our class specials time. A parent volunteer will be needed each week for each class Library and Art time.
- **Group Time /Reading** Multiple Parents/Grandparents who help in small groups for a given activity.
- **PE Volunteer** assists the coach in playing games.

#### J. UNIFORMS

- Boy & girl kindergarteners DO NOT need to wear belts.
- Girl kindergarteners MUST wear shorts under dresses.
- Sweaters/sweatshirts worn in class <u>MUST be the official wear</u> and have a collared shirt underneath.
- Hair accessories & Socks must match uniform colors.
- Shoes should not have characters/lights/wheels and should be safe for the playground.
- Please keep an extra set of clothing (including underwear) in Ziploc bag in child's backpack.
- Please label all clothing your child might take off (sweaters, sweatshirts, jackets).

### K. Bathroom

During class the signal for the bathroom is holding up the index finger to quietly indicate their need. Practice at home and please encourage your child to wash their hands each time they use the bathroom and tuck in their shirt.

# M. LIBRARY

Please make sure your child brings their library book back by library day so that she/he can check out another one. The students get very sad when they forget their book and are unable to check out a new one!

## N. CELEBRATIONS

- Birthdays: Your teacher will discuss how birthdays are celebrated in your child's classroom.
- Student Birthday Invitations may be distributed by the teacher/tutor at school only if all girls/all boys or the whole class is invited.
- Tooth Loss This is a huge deal to kindergarteners. Let us know if your child loses a tooth during the school year so we can put it on our tooth chart/graph.

## O. SNACKS Please no lunch boxes

- Your classroom teacher will discuss details on orientation night.
- Please put **one snack** into a Ziplock baggie for easy closure.
- NOTE: We do not have a refrigerator in which to store food/snacks.
- If your child has Food ALLERGIES, please let your teacher know.

## P. FIELD TRIPS

- We usually take two field trips. One of our field trips will be off-campus in the early Fall and one on-campus in the Spring.
- Student fees are due at the beginning of the year and paid online.

#### Q. MISCELLANEOUS

\*Medications: Please familiarize yourself with the procedures on the TCA website if your child needs to take medicine.

# \*Home Practice

TCA tries to respect family time. We will have home practice throughout the year, Spalding (phonograms, writing) 5 to 10 minutes daily. We will also send baggie books for reading and practice sheets for spelling words. Most importantly, we ask that you read to your child each night. Times may increase based on the needs of your child. If you are <u>spending more than 30 minutes a night on practice</u> (not including your reading time), please let your child's teacher know.

\*Discipline - Each teacher can address during orientation.

### \*What's in the Bag?

When assigned, your student will bring an object that starts with the letter of the week. The child gives three clues, and the class tries to guess the object. We will send more information to you when we begin.

# \*Baggie Reading Books

Baggie books are reader booklets that your child will take home to practice their reading. This usually starts Nov/Dec. You will receive more details from your teacher. Also, know there is a damage and lost book fee we will talk about during our orientation.

We do require children to participate in our reading groups when we send home books.
