Field Tríp

Garden of the Gods

Location: **Colorado Springs** Transportation: Bus When: September **On this field trip, we will look at the geology of the Garden of the Gods.

Location: Colorado Springs Transportation: Bus When: May **Students tour the castle as they delve deeper into Colorado history.

Specíal Events

Medieval Day

When: October 27

**Students are encouraged to come in Medieval Period clothing as they complete activities that enhance their knowledge of the medieval time period.

Pioneer Museum Visit

When: January -TBD

**A docent from the museum will visit us at school and share information to explore Colorado history.

PI Day

When: March 15

**Students participate in a variety of activities that teach about the concept of Pi.

Patriot's Day/Living Museum

When: May 10

**Following our American Revolution unit for History, we will have our Annual Patriot Day "Living Museum." Before this special day students will research (in class), make an oral presentation (in class), and make a tri-fold poster (at home) of a famous patriot. Your student may also dress up in clothing common for this era.

Heart and Lung Dissection

When: May 22

This day occurs in conjunctions with the circulatory unit in science. Students rotate through each class as they participate in activities that explore the heart and lungs.
