

Leftovers

Division Facts

Materials: Die or a regular deck of playing cards with face cards removed
45 Counters (can use buttons, cereal, Legos, etc.)

Directions:

- Play with two players.
- The object of the game is to have the most counters when the game is over.
- Player One rolls the die or draws a card and divides her counters by the number on the die or card. For example, Player One rolls a 2. She divides the counters into 2 equal groups with 1 left over. That player keeps the leftover counter and play continues with the remaining 44 counters.
- Player Two rolls a 3 and divides the remaining 44 counters by 3. She has 3 groups of 14, with 2 counters left over. Player Two keeps the 2 counters and returns the 42 remaining counters.
- Play continues until no more divisions can be made.
- The player with the most counters is the winner.
