1. UPDATED East Campus Carpool Flow - Due to a year-long construction project at PPSC, our carpool flow will have a slight change for the upcoming 2023-2024 school year. The carpool line will still enter through New Life Church and continue along Cross Peak View. Once the line moves into the lower PPSC parking lot and splits, both the K-2 line and the 3-6 line will move side by side through the drive lane to the south and the parking spaces to the south.
