OCTOBER COUNT continues this week for CSP!

This year, our count day is Monday, October 2, 2023. Through this Count, TCA reports all students who are actively enrolled and attending classes. This Count helps the State determine funding eligibility for

our students and is very important to our school, the district, and to the funding of our programs.

Because of the nature of CSP, our students must establish their attendance the week of September

25th AND the week of October 2nd. Please make every effort to have your student in attendance both of these weeks. If your student is not in attendance during these two weeks, the school must provide additional documentation to the Colorado Department of Education (CDE) that your student attended with us both before and after their absence. If you know your student will be gone for all or the majority of the count window (September 25th through October 6th), please make sure to contact your school's administration or the Registrar's office for an Intent to Return form.

Typing Pal Log-In Instructions (Grades 3-6 Only)

Typing Pal is a learn-to-type program that we offer at no charge to all of our upper elementary students. There is no requirement to participate; it's simply something families may use as part of their

home school curricula if students desire to learn/master basic typing skills. Log-in instructions are below.

- 1. Go to https://clascott.typingpal.com
- 2. Each student's **user name** is the first letter of his/her first name (as given in Infinite Campus; not a nickname) followed by the student's last name (i.e. shille would be the username for Stefani Hille).
- 3. The **password** is identical for each student—*titans*—UNLESS a student was with us previously and changed his/her account to a unique password. Once students are logged in, they may change their password to something unique to them.
