Parent-Teacher Conferences

Learning how to use a planner is one of our first goals in third grade. CogAT Testing

Part of third grade includes students taking the Cognitive Ability Test (CogAT). The CogAT measures a student's potential problem-solving skills in the areas of verbal ability (word analogies and sentence completion), quantitative ability (numeric) and nonverbal reasoning ability (puzzles, part-to-whole, and visual spatial manipulation of pictures). The test results provide us with important information helpful in meeting your student's unique learning needs. Your student will be taking the test **September 25-27th**. The test will be from 8:30-9:30 each day. Please make sure your child is here during those times.

IN OUR CURRICULUM:

<u>Spelling</u>- We will test on lists 7 & 8 on Sept. 14th. You can find our spelling lists on <u>Spelling City here.</u>

<u>Math</u>- Next week, we start <u>Chapter 2</u>, in which we will study mental math strategies. You can find some helpful hints to support your student at home <u>here</u>. We also suggest using these <u>paper</u> <u>place value discs</u> at home, if your student is needing extra support.

<u>Writing</u>-Now that students have learned

how to create a K.W.O, we will work on the rough draft of our first paper. <u>Reading</u>— Ask your student to retell how Wilber first met Charlotte.
