FOURTH GRADE CHARACTER FOCUS

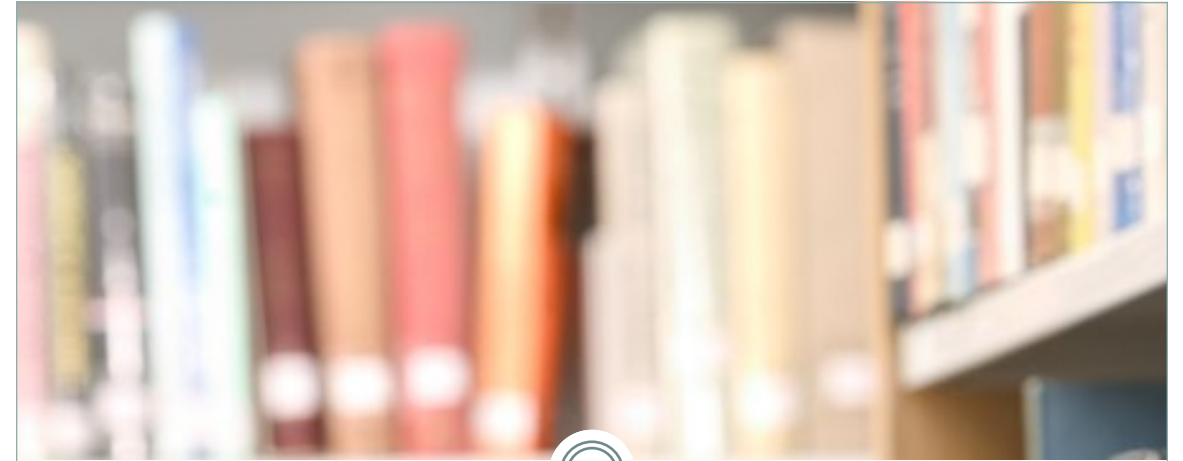
FOR DECEMBER: BRAVERY: speaking up for what is right, even if others oppose you.
