# **Reading Retell**

Students are continuing to work on recalling details and facts from books they have read. Here are some great questions you can ask your child at home after reading to help build comprehension.

- $\Rightarrow \text{ What is the main prob-} \\ \text{lem in the story?}$
- $\Rightarrow$  What is the solution?
- $\Rightarrow$  Who are the characters?
- $\Rightarrow$  What is the setting?
- ⇒ What happened at the beginning/middle/end of the story?
- ⇒ What is the topic of this story?
- $\Rightarrow$  Did you learn any facts?
