Bravery

"To be brave is to face your challenges, threats, or difficulties."

Talk about ways your student has overcome an obstacle in their life. Encourage your child to make observations of how they are being brave at home and at school.

Counting Counts!

Practicing forward and backward counting will help support your child as they add and subtract numbers. Car rides are a great time to practice! Count forward and backwards by 1s, 2s, 5s, and 10s. It's important to start at different numbers, such as starting at 7 and counting forward by 10s. Or starting at 40 and counting backwards by 5s.
