

In history this month we will learn about Westward Expansion. We will explore the pioneers heading west, new means of travel (Robert Fulton and the steamboat, the Erie Canal, and railroads), the Oregon Trail, and the Pony Express. We will also learn about Native Americans, including Sequoyah and the Cherokee alphabet, the Trail of Tears and the forced removal of Native Americans to the reservations, displacement from their homes by the "iron horse," and the effect of the near-extermination of the buffalo on the Plains Indians.
