INTRODUCTION

A previously enrolled student may obtain a Legacy status on the applicable waitlist by meeting the following criteria:

- 1. Withdrew from a TCA Program and moved out of El Paso County;
- 2. Has only been withdrawn from one school year from TCA; and
- 3. For grades 2-4 have attended all grade levels prior (minus the missed year) or for grades 5-10 have at least four continuous years of attendance at TCA.

To enter a high school grade level, the student must be able to fulfill TCA graduation requirements based on the normal graduation year sequence.

Parents are responsible for requesting legacy status, as it is not automatically tracked by the Registrar's Office. Legacy status is only applied to the waitlist for the program the student withdrew from and will place the student on that waitlist between the staff child and sibling priority statuses.
