- Dr. Sojourner highlighted the following items from his report:
  - Palmarium sent to TCA community to highlight the good things happening at TCA even during the COVID-19 outbreak
  - Expecting good news from our matching contribution challenge at the end of 2020; donations are still coming in
  - Mr. Miller not able to attend this month's meeting but the legislature does not convene until next month; hot topics will include:
    - Education funding
    - CMAS testing
  - We will delay start on the sports complex at the North Campus until May; ground is still frozen where a majority of the work needs to take place
  - COVID-19 Update
    - Outlook looks promising
      - Transmission rates are decreasing
      - Vaccine is being distributed
      - TCA community has helped curb cases by not sending sick children to school
      - TCA is one of only a handful of schools conducting in-person learning at the start of the semester
      - CHSAA has accelerated the winter sports schedule
      - TCA staff vaccinations are on their way; anticipated for late February or early March
      - TCA expected to receive approximately \$512,000 from the Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief Fund (ESSER II) to help offset expenses caused by COVID-19
