

2023-2024 Grade 2 CSP Supply List

Please purchase all items listed below and bring them the first day of school. Bring the Community and ART Supplies to school for the Meet and Greet or on the 2nd day of school.

The following must fit inside your child's pencil bag and should be labeled with your child's name:

- 1 pencil bag (8" X 5") – **PLEASE, NO PENCIL BOXES!**
- 1 white rubber eraser
- 1 box 12 – count Crayola Twistables colored pencils
- 1 small box of thin washable, non-toxic markers (no permanent markers)
- 1 pair blunt-tipped metal scissors
- 2 dry erase markers
- 1 large glue stick or 3 small glue sticks
- 3 two-pocket, **three prong** folders; labeled with name and subject (**blue = TAKE HOME; green = GRAMMAR; yellow = CLASSICAL ELEMENTS**)
- 1 wide ruled black and white composition book**
- 1 one-subject, wide-ruled spiral notebook

Additional supplies for Second Grade:

- Backpack (large enough to hold supplies) – NO rolling backpacks, please!
- Water bottle with a secure lid
