8:50	Guest Speaker- Krystal Hearne-Core Knowledge. Taught at the original TCA, has been a curriculum director, assistant Principal and Principal. Has worked for Core knowledge for years. Always wanted to have children at TCA because of the Core Knowledge.	Krystal Hearne

The Core Knowledge founder is E.D. Hirsch, JR. Taught English in the 70s and found that college students didn't have a broad base of knowledge from reading and comprehension and thus weren't able to write informed essays.

- Founded Core Knowledge Foundation in 1986. Hundreds of people worked on the creation of this curriculum.
- o 1987 wrote Cultural Literacy. The goal was to "teach a shared curriculum"
- Came out with a core knowledge sequence. Krystal showed a picture of the latest sequence from Kinder -8th grade.
- o Read Classical Academy mission statement.
- Are you amazed at what your children are learning here at TCA?
 They are learning such a broad base of knowledge and it's exciting!
 They are also learning great character traits from what they are learning.
- This curriculum is coherent and cumulative. For example, the Sun, Moon and Stars are the science starting point. Then they learn plant and animal survival which builds on previous knowledge, then they move to light and sound, building on the previous subject matter.
- O Parent question: How often and why is it updated? To add history that has happened, science updates, etc.
- O Showed more examples of Systematic Knowledge Building and how it works with the classical approach.
- This curriculum is cross curricular. What they are learning in history goes throughout the school- from art to language art.
- This curriculum is content rich. In schools that don't have core knowledge, the content is generally not as rich.
- There is no math curriculum for Core Knowledge, but they recommend Saxon Math or Singapore math. These are our former and current math curriculums, respectively.
- Knowing about the subject matter makes it easier to learn about what you read. It fills in gaps, resolves ambiguity, and promote equity.
- It plays an integral part in critical thinking skills.
