Thank you for volunteering to be a room parent at TCA North Elementary! To help make your life easier, this information is being provided to you to describe and outline some of the room parent activities you may be asked to help with during your year.

The primary purpose of the room parent is to support the teacher, make sure the teacher's voice and plans are heard by all parents in the classroom and upon the teacher's request, communicate with parents. Room parents also help with building relationships with the parents in the class and coordinating parental involvement.

In addition to supporting the teacher, the room parent also serves as the first point of contact on the classroom level for school events to engage parental support. For these events, you will be working with your class level Room Parent Liaison (RPL) to ensure that all parents in the classroom have an opportunity to hear about and contribute to all school events.

Each grade level has a Room Parent Liaison (RPL) that serves as the primary contact for school wide and grade level events for the classroom room parents. RPL's work with school staff and administration to maintain a school wide focus in each grade level, then communicate with the Room Parents who in turn bring information to the classroom level. The RPL for each grade is responsible for coordination and support of the school wide event, to ensure that each grade level has the opportunity to support the school as a whole. North Elementary has many volunteer opportunities in addition to those in the classroom: Field Day, Art Show Support, Concerts, Friends of the Library, and the North Parent Partnership events!
