Students will continue to practice and develop deeper understanding of the 70+ phonograms and rules of the English language. Sentence construction will be emphasized, and students will begin to learn the characteristics of exemplary writing. A spelling test will be given each week covering the words that they have been analyzing during the week. These lists will be in the newsletters and located on the second-grade website under Curriculum Overview.

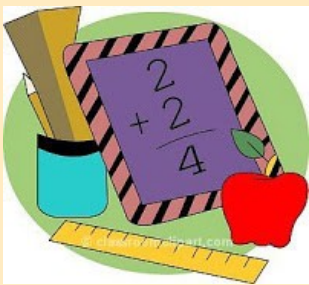
**Even though we will study the words in class, please also help your child study the spelling words at home for their weekly spelling tests.

Literature

Your child will be hearing, reading, and retelling quality literature and reciting classic poetry. Your child should always have a book in his/her desk to read during silent reading time and when assignments are completed. Please encourage your child to read for pleasure at home. The best way to do this is to read often with your children, listening to them and reading to them. Try to find books that you both enjoy and have fun together!

Dimensions Math

Homework will be assigned approximately 4 nights a week. For most students, this will take about 15 minutes to complete. Please look over your child's work to make sure they are understanding the concepts. Your child should bring home and return this homework in their take-home folder/backpack each day. Also, please help your child practice math facts as an additional part of their homework. By the end of second grade, the expectations is that all students will have learned 0-20 addition and subtraction facts, as well as 2,3, 4, 5, and 10 multiplication facts.

Book Talks

Each semester of second grade, students will “talk” about one book they have read. Teachers will guide students in selecting one biography book and one nonfiction book.

Art of Learning

Students will also study the lives and works of Thomas Cole, Marc Chagall, and Aaron Copland as well as the wondrous world of nature surrounding our school building. Emphasis will be on careful observation and narration. The art and composer studies will take place with the Art and Music teachers, while nature studies will take place with the classroom.



Discipline

We will continue to work with students on making good choices, as well as building meaningful habits and relationships. Teachers are usually able to work through issues when they arise and we try not to send students to the office. However, there may be times when a student will need to have a discussion with a principal. If this happens, the teacher or principal will notify parents if need be.

Birthdays

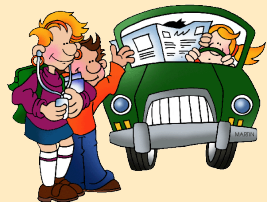
Please check with your child’s teacher concerning specifics for birthday celebrations. Students are welcome to bring in a birthday snack to share on the prearranged day.
