## Literacy Testing

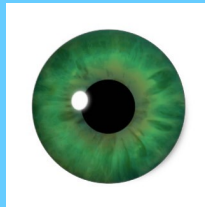
Thank you for partnering with us to make literacy testing successful! We will test one last time at the end of the year to see the wonderful growth made in third grade!
