

## **TCA 5th/6th Citation Format**

*The purpose of this form is to develop students' skills for locating necessary citation information.*

***Citations should be in a horizontal list format and punctuated as indicated.***

### **Book:**

Author Last Name, First Name. *Title*, year of publication.

### **Website:**

Author Last Name, First Name (if given). "Title of article." Website URL (stop after .edu, .org or .com), date you accessed information.

### **Print Encyclopedia:**

Author Last Name, First Name (if given). "Title of article." *Title of Encyclopedia*, year, page number.

### **Online Encyclopedia:**

Author Last Name, First Name (if given). "Title of article." Website URL (stop after .edu, .org or .com), date you accessed information.

### **Electronic Database:**

Author Last Name, First Name (if given). "Title of article." *Title of database*, date you accessed information.

### **Personal Interview:**

Last Name, First name of the person interviewed. Personal interview. Date of the interview.

### **Image from a book:**

Creator Last Name, First Name (if given). "Title of piece." *Title of book*, author or editor of book, year of publication, page number.

### **Image from a website:**

Creator Last Name, First Name (if given). "Title of piece." Website URL (stop after .edu, .org or .com), date you accessed information.
