#### Grammar

Our grammar curriculum is Easy Grammar. The first unit starts with prepositions. Today I sent home a list of prepositions in your child's 3-ring binder. The students will need to memorize these for a test we will have in two weeks (Sept. 15). If your child has memorized a different list, he/she can use these for the test but they must all be prepositions.

I will work on grammar skills in school and send home supplemental sheets. These are not mandatory and will not be turned in to me. However, I think you will find your child will score higher on the quizzes and be able to remember the concepts better if he/she does them.
