# Following and Supporting Your Child's Academic Success

## Helping Your Child Stay Up-to-date With Their Work Student Planner:

Every student receives a school provided day planner and teachers offer them time each week to write down their assignments. Regularly looking at your child's day planner with them helps keep you connected with their assignments and how they are staying on top of their work.

#### Infinite Campus Parent Portal (Description of the links):

**Calendar:** This link will allow you to see the assignments due this week for all their classes. You place your cursor over the "A+" and it will show the assignments for that day. It provides a great resource to use when looking at your child's student planner with them.

**Reports:** Offers a link to a report that shows all your child's missing assignments,

report card, and more.

**To Do List:** Shows all your child's assignments past and coming up in the near future.

**Messages:** Lists all the messages that have been sent to your account through Infinite Campus by teachers and administrators.

#### **Getting Support:**

#### **After School Workshop:**

There are two workshops to assist students who are struggling to complete their homework or need extra support in mathematics. We provide support in a workshop format with a teacher present from 3:15 PM - 4:50 PM. The General Workshop is held in one of our junior high computer labs from 3:00 PM - 4:00 PM. Our Math Workshop takes place in room 3307 from 3:00 PM - 4:50 to offer students homework help or more math support. These workshops are free and take place on the Junior High floor.

#### **Contacting A Teacher:**

Please contact your child's teacher if you have questions or concerns about your child's academic success. Teachers in English/Language Arts and Mathematics will sometimes pull struggling students in during FLEX time to provide extra support.

#### **After School Supervision:**

Each day at 3:15 PM the Junior High floor is cleared. Students can attend one of the Junior High Workshops mentioned above or be picked up by their parents. Parents should plan on picking up their child by 3:45 PM unless their child is attending an after school school workshop that will end later in the afternoon.

#### **Character Education:**

There are many teachable moments in character lessons that naturally connect to the daily content of our classes, development of habits, and living in a school community. Most weeks your student will attend a Titan Team on Wednesday to celebrate, relate, serve, and discuss character topics. Our character topics will be posted to the Junior High Website so that you can <a href="CONVERSATION">CONTINUE THE</a>
<a href="CONVERSATION">CONVERSATION</a> at home. Many of these character topics are great conversation starters that will provide an opportunity to get your child talking about character.

#### **Weekly Announcements:**

<u>Weekly announcements</u> are sent home and posted on the Junior High Website. This is a great way two keep in touch with the events at the school.
