Parent-Teacher Conferences

OCTOBER 5-6

If you have not already received a signup to schedule a conference time with your teacher, you will receive it soon. We are looking forward to meeting with you to discuss your student's school year.

Learning how to use a planner is one of our first goals in third grade. All homework and upcoming special events will be listed in the planner. **Students are required to obtain a parent signature in their planner every night.** Thank you for partnering with us to establish good homework habits this year.

CogAT Testing

Part of third grade includes students taking the Cognitive Ability Test (CogAT). The CogAT measures a student's potential problem-solving skills in the areas of verbal ability (word analogies and sentence completion), quantitative ability (numeric) and nonverbal reasoning ability (puzzles, part-to-whole, and visual spatial manipulation of pictures). The test results provide us with important information helpful in meeting your student's unique learning needs. Your student will be taking the test **September 25-27th**. The test will be from 8:30-9:30 each day. Please make sure your child is here during those times.

IN OUR CURRICULUM:

<u>Spelling</u> – We will test on lists 5 & 6 on Sept. 8th. You can find our spelling lists on <u>Spelling City here.</u>

<u>Math</u>- We will take our <u>Chapter 1.</u> test on place value and comparing numbers, next week. Please help your child remember to return their math workbook to school EVERY DAY.

<u>Writing</u>-To help prepare us for writing, we will be looking at passages, creating key word outlines, and telling back. <u>Reading</u> – Our first book is <u>Charlotte's Web.</u> Ask your student what actions reflect a good friend.

<u>Recitation</u> - <u>Catch a Little Rhyme</u>

Due the week of September 25th. (A recitation schedule for the year has been posted on the 3rd grade website.)

<u>Science</u>- Ask your student to tell you along with describing metamorphosis of a butterfly.
