### **FOURTH GRADE CHARACTER FOCUS FOR MARCH PERSEVERENCE:**

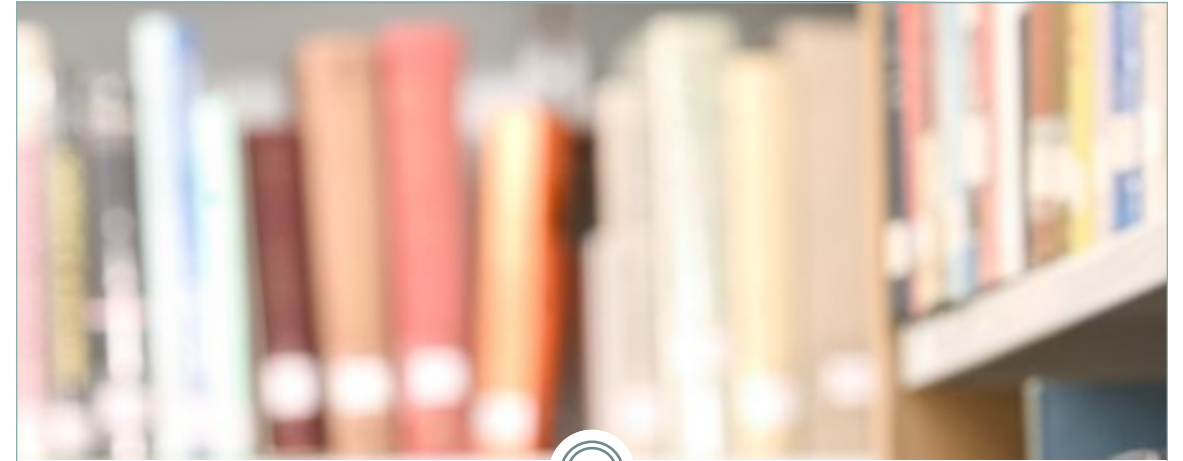
Finish what you start! Take pleasure in completing your tasks.
