CURIOSITY: taking an interest in a topic and finding it fascinating; exploring and discovering a topic of interest

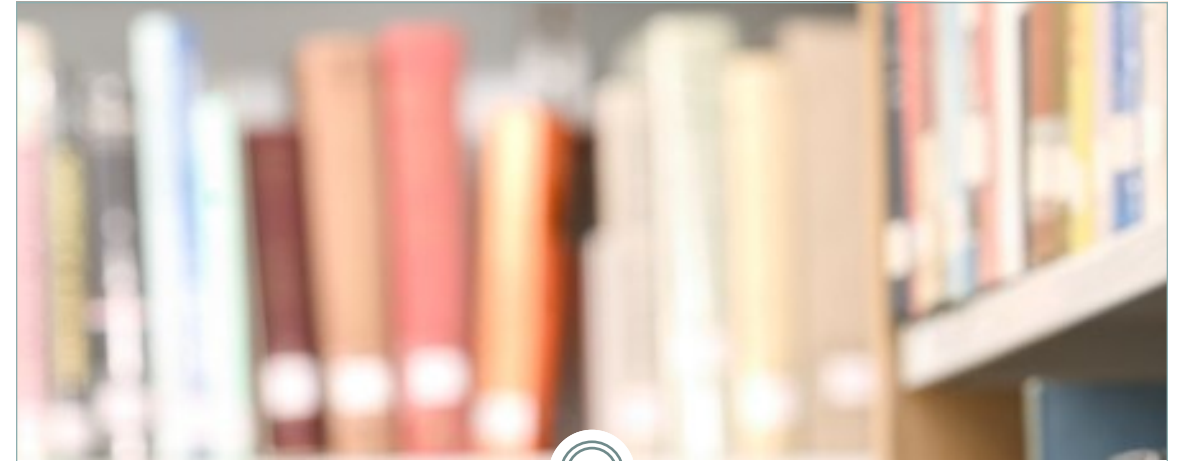
DINNER DISCUSSION: What is something you are curious about? How are you planning to learn/discover more about it?
