Board Member Election News

Education Alliance of Colorado

The Board voted to allocate \$6300 to fulfill TCA's initial organizational dues for the Education Alliance of Colorado (EAC). Thirteen schools, representing 13,000 students, have already signed up. The EAC was formed as a grassroots effort to help parents have their voices heard in legislative decisions regarding school choice and charter schools.
