The newly formed Pandemic Response Committee (PRC) provided an update and report to the Board following their initial meeting with the Administration and COVID Response Team (CRT) members. The PRC proposed an Emergency/Pandemic Response Protocols Policy, which was amended and approved by the Board. The PRC and CRT will continue to work together to update the Policy, while also developing and administering protocols, communications, issues related to mental health, and parent/student/staff advocacy.

## Education Alliance of Colorado

Board members Rob Moulton and Teri Goin updated the Board about the Education Alliance of Colorado (EAC), which is now fully operational. The EAC is currently reviewing potential legislative bills which would affect charter schools and school choice, and are working to grow their team of parent advocates.
