- Mr. VanGampleare reminded the Board that this is a very preliminary look at what the budget could be this year but was optimistic that the PPF will increase this year; overall TCA is in a good financial position
 - Better state budget information will be available as we get closer to the Colorado legislature Per Pupil Funding for FY19-20
 - TCA will continue to budget conservatively

- PERA costs will continue to rise for TCA and staff
- o TCA's medical claims are trending within budgeted levels

Rationale: to review and assess TCA student achievement

- Mr. Jolly reviewed the overall academic assessment, accreditation, and achievement for TCA's schools and noted that overall, TCA continues to perform at high levels when comparing all of the test scores our students are taking (state tests, AP tests, SAT, etc.) to state, ASD20 (high performing district), and national standards
 - The state accredited all of our schools at the highest level Performance Plan
 - There is a positive trend that more of our students are taking state tests
 - Although we are still performing at high levels, we will continue to focus on Science at Elementary and Junior High, in addition to Math and English Language Arts academic growth at Junior High
- Mr. Jolly emphasized the following from his report:
 - The academic leadership team will continue to be vigilant on our performance, while remembering, as noted in our Core Values: "The foremost measure of our success now and in the future is how well we live up to the words of this document, and to a lesser extent by test scores, number of students enrolled, number of students on our waitlist, and other outside measures of success."
